

Advisory for Supervisor Selection & Synopsis Submission to Pre-Ph.D. Course-Work Qualified Candidates

1. After qualifying the Pre-PhD Course Work, the candidate interacts with the Supervisors whose names are mentioned in the List of Supervisors declared by the University for that batch.
2. The candidate apply to the Research Centre (Institute/College) of the prospective Supervisor by a written application in which he/she has mention the three names of choices of their prospective Supervisor in an order along with Application form of that Research Centre (Institute/College).
3. When applications are received at Research Centre, then concerning subject department arrange a meeting of Counselling Committee where all the applicants and approved prospective Supervisors of that department are called to attend the meeting. The allocation of the supervisor for an eligible student shall be decided by the counselling committee comprising of:
 - (i) The Dean or the Director of Institute or Principal of a college
 - (ii) Head\In-charge of the Department
 - (iii) Prospective supervisors
4. The Counselling Committee issue a letter to the candidate informing the name of the Supervisor in which student can work and then they start preparing their Synopsis for his research work.
5. After preparing the synopsis in consultation with the Supervisor, student purchase University Registration Form for Ph.D. from Publication Department of the University and deposit in the Research Section of the University along with prescribed fees, required documents and synopsis
6. The synopsis should contain Title, Introduction (covering general importance, justification in the present times), Literature review, Objectives, Hypothesis (if applicable), Work plan and Methodology, Impact of Utility of proposed work, References/Bibliography
7. After submission University Registration Form for Ph.D., candidate attend the Research Degree Committee (RDC) meeting on the prescribed date declared by the University on University website and defends the proposal.
